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Construction Update - May 15, 2024

The City of Lockport has started work on the Illinois Route 7 Channelization project to decrease traffic congestion, increase safety and maximize corridor connectivity.

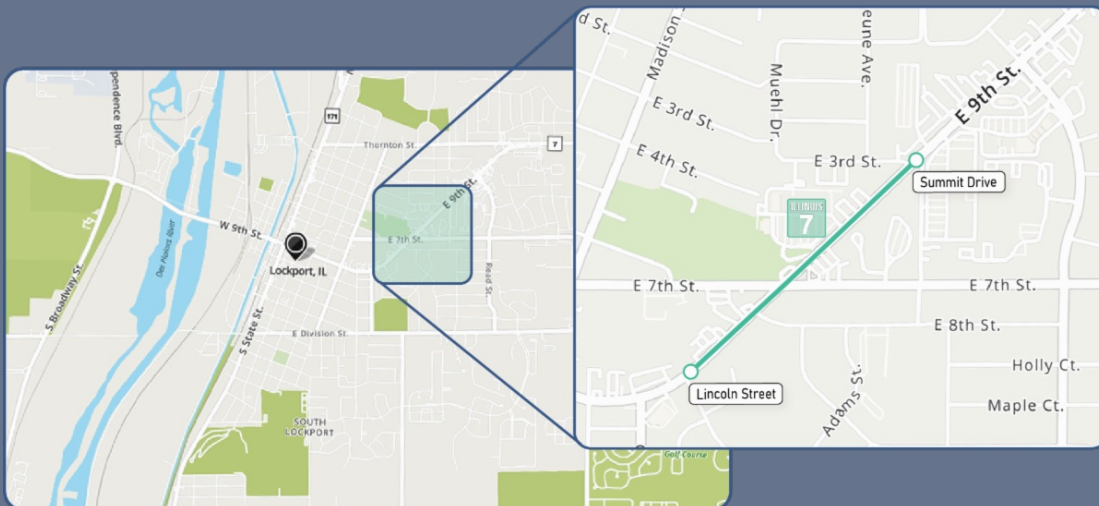
Currently, this area includes a two-lane road with shoulders, resulting in traffic backups from frequent left turns across traffic. The project will include installing a bidirectional turn lane down the center of the roadway to improve safety and traffic flow throughout the corridor.

Last week, the contractor turned on the temporary signal installation at 7th Street and removed the existing signal while AT&T completed utility relocation work. No work is scheduled for this week but progress will continue this month.
